HSA or FSA ACCOUNT HOLDERS BEWARE

We recently learned that under the new health care law, consumers using workplace pre-tax health savings accounts will soon need a doctor's note to pay for Tylenol and an estimated 15,000 other over-the-counter drugs. The IRS says any funds removed from HSA accounts to pay for medical expenses that are purchased without a prescription will be included as taxable income and subject to an additional tax of 20 percent. This measure takes effect January 1, 2011 for employees who use flexible spending accounts (FSAs), health saving accounts (HSAs), or health reimbursement arrangements (HRAs) to pay for common medications such as pain relievers, cold medicines, antacids and allergy medications will need prescriptions.
