Lee Prosser, former President of NTCB (2006 – 2008) and Chairman of Health Associations, passed suddenly 7/10/11 at his home.

Lee Prosser was born in Missouri during 1944 and has written for publication since 1963. In his early career he wrote under the names of Harold Lee Prosser, and H. L. Prosser. Since 1989, he has written under the name of Lee Prosser. He has written over 4,000 published works in his lifetime. Chairman of Health Associations.

Prosser was married to herbalist-writer, Debra J. Prosser and was a devoted father and grandfather. His hobbies included geology, collecting postcards, collecting the writings of Mark Twain, visiting out of the way places and cemeteries, exploring ghost towns, and writing children's stories.

A lifelong paranormal sensitive, Prosser wrote a metaphysical column, "Bide One's Time" for www.ghostvillage.com, and as well as reviews for www.jazzreview.com.

He is also a composer and a surreal artist whose art work is in Russia, England, Germany, India, France, and the United States. His musical compositions include "Ramakrishna Waltz."

His eclectic writings have appeared in books by Jeff Belanger, Gerina Dunwich, James Gunn, among others. Prosser is the author of the popular memoir, *Isherwood, Bowles, Vedanta, Wicca, and Me*; some of his other books include *Missouri Hauntings*, *Branson Hauntings*, *Night Tigers* (essays), *Running From the Hunter: The Life and Works of Charles Beaumont* (biography).
